

Educational Leader of The Year Award by Region

Criteria: An individual, who is in a leadership, consultative or supervisory capacity and who, in the opinion of the Region Chapters, has made a significant contribution to exceptional children and youth.

Token: An engraved plaque

Presented: At the Annual Provincial Conference

This award need not be presented in all Regions if a suitable candidate is not available.

Guidelines:

1. Individuals nominated do not need to be members of CEC.
2. The individual cannot be a current officer of CEC (Provincial) or a current member of the Awards Committee.
3. Individuals should have shown leadership by contributing to the welfare of exceptional children and youth in any or all of the following ways:
 - Involved in the development of programs and/or services for exceptional students
 - Increased the awareness of parents, administrators, and the community regarding exceptional students
 - Submitted an article or paper for publication at the local, provincial, national or international level
 - Promoted staff development relating to special education.
4. Any educational leader the Chapters feel should be recognized.
5. At least one letter of support and a resume/curriculum vitae must accompany nomination.
6. The Chapter Presidents in a Region must forward the name of the nominee to the Awards Committee by July 31. Please note that one recipient per Region will be selected by the Awards Committee.
