

The President's Award to a CEC Member

- Criteria:** A member of CEC who has contributed in any of several ways, to the work of CEC or exceptional children and youth
- Token:** An engraved plaque
- Presented:** At the Annual Provincial Conference

Guidelines:

1. The individual nominated should be a current member in good standing and have been a member of CEC for a minimum of three years.
2. Individuals should have contributed to the welfare of exceptional children and youth on a local or province-wide basis. (e.g. legislation, program development, recreation, curriculum, Ontario CEC service, education of the public).
3. The individual cannot be a current officer of Ontario CEC or a current member of the Awards Committee.
4. At least one letter of support and a resume must accompany nomination.

Examples of Types of Individuals to be Considered Include:

1. Author of a major CEC publication or report.
2. Longstanding membership in CEC with significant contributions in a number of areas. (e.g. committees, etc.).
3. Significant contribution at all levels of CEC (local, provincial, national and/or international)
4. An individual showing leadership and significant contribution to CEC development.
5. Any CEC member that the local Chapter determines should be recognized.
